
Pairing with Amazon Alexa






Enter the Amazon Alexa interface and navigate to “more”, then “skills and games”



Search and find the “TTLock” API



Enable to use the “TTLock” API



Log in with TTLock credentials found in the DatoHome app
(Me --> Personal Settings --> TTLock Account & Password)

Smart Home devices must be discovered before they can be used with Alexa.








Alexa is looking for devices to connect...


After successfully linking TTTLock with Amazon Alexa, the device will automatically request to discover devices. Press "Discover Devices"



Go to the Amazon Alexa interface: Devices --> Locks, choose the nearby lock. Give it a fitting name.



Enable “unlock by voice” to access voice control.
Choose your voice code.
This will prompt the Amazon Alexa login interface.
Log in with your Amazon credentials.
